

# TECHNICAL DATA SHEET CANDY APPLE BASECOAT – RAINBOW FINISH

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Spray Chief's Candy Apple Basecoat – Rainbow Finish is a unique product, manufactured in Australia to suit the Australian market and conditions. When used over Spray Chief's Micro Silver Basecoat or Silver Base Basecoat, this product, which utilises light interfering pigments, generates the most glamorous and vibrant transparent finish with a spectacular prism effect. When clear coated with Spray Chief's 2K Clear (HS) 2:1, a high gloss finish with excellent durability and depth is achieved.

#### **SUITABLE SUBSTRATES**

#### **MIXING RATIO**

- 1 part Spray Chief Candy Apple Basecoat Rainbow Finish colour by volume.
- 50 80% Spray Chief Basecoat Reducer by volume.
- If required, 5% by volume of Spray Chief 2:1 MS Hardener can be added to the Candy Apple Basecoat – Rainbow Finish colour, before thinning, to activate it.

#### **SPRAY GUN AND PRESSURE**

SPRAY GUN & PRESSURE:

• Use HVLP gravity fed gun

• Tip: 1.3 – 1.5 mm


• Pressure: 350 - 400 kPa

• Fan Size: 15 – 20 cm



#### **APPLICATION**

- All surfaces must be thoroughly sanded and cleaned with a suitable Wax
   & Grease Remover prior to application.
- Stir thoroughly before use.
- For a better finish, with improvements in adhesion and durability, mix the Spray Chief Candy Apple Basecoat Rainbow Finish colour with 5% by volume of Spray Chief 2:1 MS Hardener, before adding the reducer.
- To achieve the correct look, Spray Chief's Candy Apple Basecoat –
  Rainbow Finish must be applied over two to three coats of Spray Chief's
  Micro Silver Basecoat or Silver Base Basecoat. (See the TDS for these
  products for the correct application procedure).
- Once the correct base has been applied:
  - ➤ Apply one medium to wet coat of the Spray Chief Candy Apple Basecoat Rainbow Finish colour, allowing 5 to 10 minutes to flash off, or until touch dry.
  - ➤ Then apply up to four to five even medium to wet coats, with a minimum 50% spray pattern.
  - Allow each coat to flash off for 5 to 10 minutes at 25°C, before applying the next coat.
  - ➤ **NOTE:** This is a multiple coat system, it is very important to take your time when applying the required coats to achieve the colour depth required. To achieve the best finish it must be applied evenly.
  - Allow a window of approximately 1 to 2 hours, but no longer than 6 hours, before applying Spray Chief's 2K Clear (HS) 2:1 (See the relevant TDS).
  - ➤ WARNING: The spraying environment must be clean and free from any dust particles. Because any particle landing in the Candy Apple Basecoat Rainbow Finish colour will be highlighted dramatically, in the finished product.
  - ➤ **NOTE:** The main problem with applying this product is patchiness and streaking in the colour. As the coating is transparent, the more coats applied the darker the colour will be. The thickness of the paint film must be even over the entire vehicle. You must spray the entire side of the vehicle, as per the diagram.
